This cute B&B is perfect for a weekend break by the seaside...

Location:

Split over two Victorian town houses in the vibrant and stylish Kemp Town, overlooking New Steine Green, this traditional B&B is just a short stroll to Brighton's iconic pier and pebble beaches. It's also convenient for browsing the famous bustling Lanes, with their quirky independent boutiques. It's perfectly placed for a weekend break. With the Brighton festival on till June 5, it's a stone's (pebble's?!) throw from the key venues – the hotel even hosts a bit of Festival Fringe art. The Brighton Wheel is nearby and the Sea Life aquarium is just round the corner. It's great value for a central location.

Bedrooms:

Decorated in neutral tones with a splash of burgundy, the well-planned bedrooms are equipped with every magazine and leaflet to ensure you explore Brighton fully. All rooms include toiletries, a hairdryer and hot drink-making facilities – there's shortbread for dipping too! All the characteristics you would expect from a Victorian house are present, with sash windows, wooden blinds and a table and chairs in the bay window – ideal for taking in the sea view.

Restaurants and bars:

Venture out for dinner at one of Brighton's many lovely restaurants. We ate at Indian eatery The Chilli Pickle, opting for a thali, so we could try a bit of everything. And we were not disappointed. The large, open-plan, modern restaurant was great for big groups and the friendly and knowledgeable waiters helped to ensure everyone left satisfied. The restaurant has a very chilled atmosphere and is the perfect pre-show dinner location for the Brighton Dome. This is a popular hotspot so booking is a must!

Facilities:

This four-star hotel puts the "breakfast" into B&B, with two menus – continental or traditional – all made with locally sourced produce. I chose the chef's special: Sussex egg on delicious bread served with avocado and a sprinkle of paprika. The hotel also offers in-room massages, which might be just the ticket before a night

exploring the lively bars of trendy Kemp Town.

Rooms start at £57.50. The New Steine Hotel is offering 10 per cent discount off its best available rates when you book direct and quote "festival" followed by the name of the show or exhibition that you will be seeing while in town.
